“Who could have imagined that children as young as seven years old could be considered content creators for social media platforms?” said Attorney Lamoureux. “This is all well and good *if* parents are paying strict attention to what their children are posting and if they stay up-to-date with sites and apps they are using. If they are not, danger abounds. Parents need to be at least one step ahead to protect their children. They also need to aware that they may be held responsible for what their children post online.”
