**Pannone Lopes Devereaux & West Partner Teno A. West, to speak at national conference
on private-public sector partnerships**

Providence, Rhode Island (November 16, 2009) – Teno A. “Building partnerships between the public and private sectors through progressive alternative delivery projects that incorporate emerging technology and cost efficiencies is the nexus of success for commercial businesses and government entities now and in the future,” said West. “The key is to seek collaboration between the private and public sectors to reach common ground – a relatively new concept for the public sector that is gaining traction in the United States.”

West represents government agencies across the country with respect to PPP projects being undertaken pursuant to alternative delivery approaches, design-build and design-build-operate, and has drafted legislation required for the undertaking of such alternative procurements.
